School History

In 1978, Father Ron Molrine, St. Anne's Rector at the time, wanted to expand St. Anne's Episcopal Church's outreach into the community. The need for a well-run, well staffed nursery school in the Trexlertown area was particularly strong in the late 1970's, when the population of young families with pre-school aged children grew dramatically. Father Molrine was instrumental in starting a non-denominational nursery school in the new church building. The school began in the parish hall with a small group of children. Now, 40 years later the school has expanded into the educational wing of the church occupying 4 classrooms. We may be a small school, but we are a mighty school!
