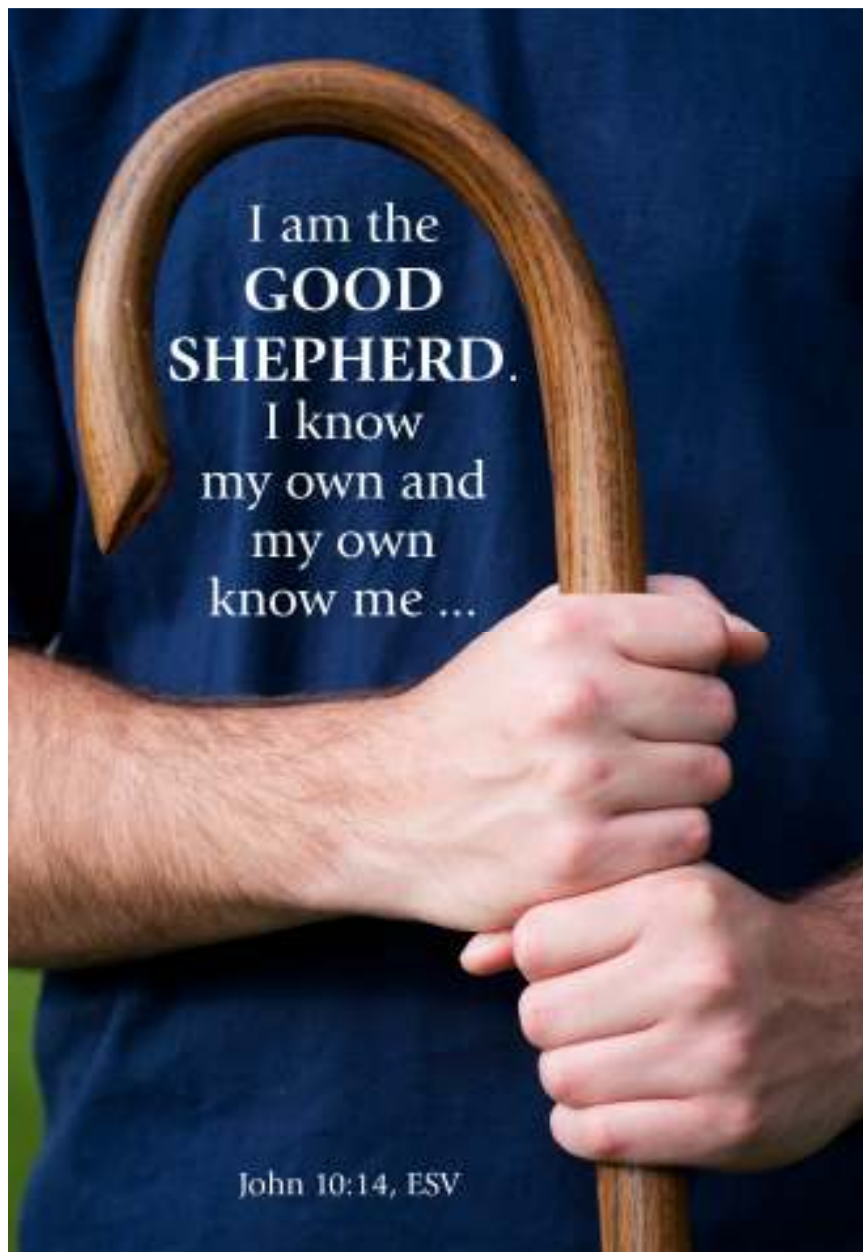


# St. Anne's Episcopal Church Calendar & Announcements April 22 - 29
