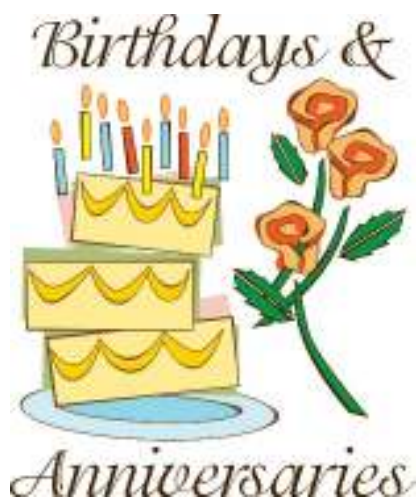

**Collection will conclude Sunday, June 3**

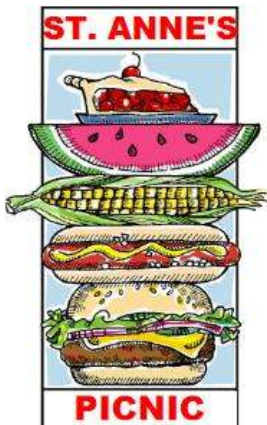
