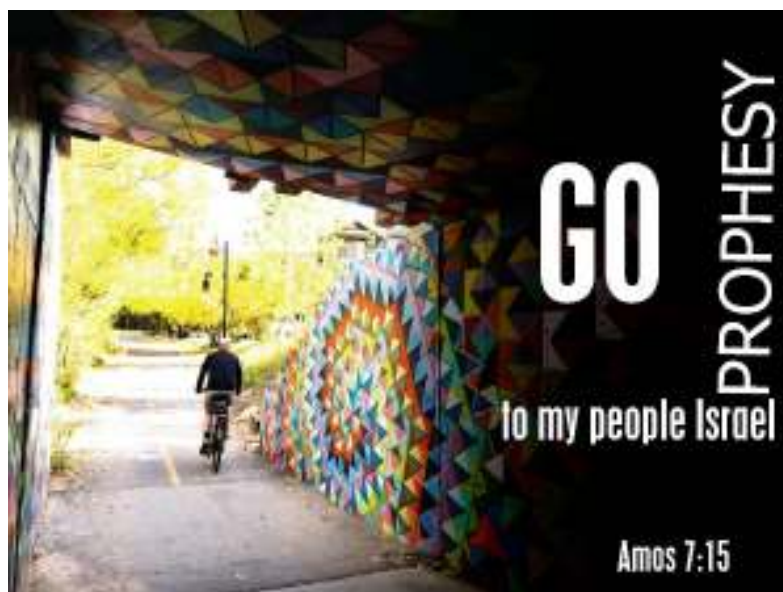

BUILDING MAINTENANCE ITEMS NEED HELPING HANDS



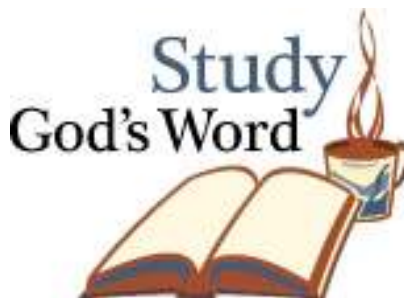
There are a few things that really need "fixing" and we don't have anyone to do them. Would you be available to help? Please contact Fr. Don or the parish office.

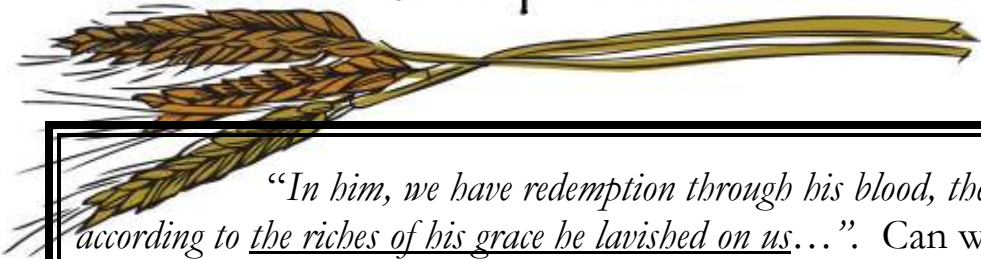
